

BIO-DrIM travel award for the FOCIS Course in Advanced Basic and Clinical Immunology

We are pleased to announce that we will award up to € 2.500,00 in travel grants for the FOCIS European Advanced Course 2016, to be held October 17th-19th 2016 at the Pasteur Institute, Paris, France.

The awards will provide travel support to European and Non-European students and postdoctoral fellows in the field of transplantation and/or immunology selected for posters. Selection will be based on the originality and significance of the research being presented.

Attendance at the Course and presentation of the poster is mandatory.

The award recipient will be reimbursed (in accordance with the German Travel Expenses Act) up to € 1.250,00 with expenses associated with attending the course (registration fee, travel, lodging).

Expenses will be reimbursed upon the presentation of properly prepared reimbursement forms and must be accompanied by receipts to be sent to application@biodrim.eu. Requests without receipts will not be honored.

Eligible expenses will only be reimbursed after the conclusion of the travel.

The BIO-DrIM award can not be combined with other grants. It is a prerequisite that applicants acknowledge the BIO-DrIM project for the award with the following sentence:

“The research leading to these results has received funding from the European Commission Seventh Framework Programme ([FP7/2007-2013] [FP7/2007-2011]) under grant agreement n° 305147 BIO-DrIM”.

Applicants are required to provide a completed application form.

Applications must be sent to application@biodrim.eu. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Material sent separately, through regular mail, will not be accepted.

We will accept applications received from June 1st, 2016 to June 30th, 2016.

The award recipients will be notified by July 31st, 2016.
